Prayers For General Conference 2019

The United Methodist Church's highest legislative assembly, General Conference, is scheduled to meet February 23-26, 2019 to consider the future of the denomination. Several plans for "a way forward" have been proposed by a commission of that name. General Conference may adopt, amend, rewrite, or reject these proposals. It may "punt" to the next regularly scheduled General Conference in 2020 to make another decision. Each of the plans focuses on how to restructure the United Methodist Church based on differing opinions about homosexuality. Further resources for this special General Conference can be found on the North Georgia Conference website, ngumc.org.

The limits of my article in this newsletter keep me from going into great detail, but currently the UMC officially declares "the practice of homosexuality" to be "incompatible with Christian teaching." As a result, the denomination forbids ordination of "self-avowed practicing homosexuals," celebration of same-sex marriages or unions, and the use of general church funds to promote the acceptance of homosexuality.

The United Methodist Church has publicly struggled with these issues for over 50 years. Nobody knows for sure what the General Conference may decide during its February meeting. We may keep the same stance or there might be a new way of living as a faith community with our different opinions and beliefs. We as the North Georgia Annual Conference and as a local church may have to make decisions after the General Conference. It's just too early to know for sure what is going to happen.

But here is what I can promise you WON'T happen during or after the conference: the sky won't fall, United Methodists will continue to serve Christ and "conference" together to "speak the truth in love," and I will continue to pastor the people of Chapelwood United Methodist Church, no matter what your beliefs and opinions are on these matters.

In fact, I would enjoy hearing from you. I would love to know your thoughts. But in the meantime, let us all be in prayer for the delegates to the special called General Conference. And let us all pray for God's love, justice, and truth to reign in the United Methodist Church.




